


# Welcome to IES Växjö Newsletter 15 April 2024

The survey should be visible on the start page underneath the news panel, called "Inquiries", and may require some scrolling to find. Once you find it, clicking on the text will bring you to the survey.

The survey is a vitally important part of our systematic quality work, and we hope all guardians will be able to respond to the survey before the 10th of May.'

A senior in 7A earned 18 merit slips. More awards and "fika" with Mr. Owens is just around the corner.



Jag bemöter alla barn med kärlek och försöker se deras behov och kunskaper för att kunna anpassa undervisningen utifrån deras nivå och intresse. Jag håller i en varierande undervisning och eleverna lär sig främst genom lek, PowerPoint-presentationer, klassisk undervisning, samt genom att arbeta i par, grupp och individuellt."



The bridge between preschool and school

I try to create a safe environment for the children starting in preschool class. Feeling safe with me and in the group is important so that the pupils can experience joy and dare to say what they want and think. The goal is for pupils to have the courage to ask questions and learn new things. Safe children learn faster because they can focus on learning. I treat all children with love and try to understand their needs and abilities in order to adapt my teaching to their level and interests. I provide a variety of teaching methods and students learn mainly through games, PowerPoint presentations, classical teaching, and working in pairs, groups and individually.

### Mr Abbas, Year 1 mentor:

"Bra förtroende och relationer är nyckeln som öppnar flera dörrar! Good trust and relationships are the key that opens several doors! From my perspective, students' relations with the environment throughout the school, whether it is inside the classroom or outside at break time, play an important role in building trust and



strengthening relations between each other and with adults around. It is about forming a good key that can open multiple doors to good opportunities, enjoyment and learning.


