


IES Upplands Väsby News V.40

Dear all,

On Monday, the students in grades 8 and 9 listened to a lecture about ANDT. What is important in this area, is that all students have the right to a health-promoting school environment that is free from alcohol, drugs, doping and tobacco, and characterised by good relationships with peers and teachers. The students also have the right to have education where issues related to tobacco, alcohol, drugs and doping are integrated into various subjects to get a more complex picture of these areas.



On Tuesday we had a student council where we spent our time discussing the fun theme days that we hold in our school throughout the year. The students wish to continue with fun days and like the opportunity to dress up in fun outfits. We also discussed how we could use some of these days for charitable organisations, and concluded that in the future we should choose charities to support and try to raise money for them.

During the autumn break, IES Upplands Väsby will offer "Lovskola" for students in year 9 who are at risk of not being eligible for gymnasium after they complete Year 9. It is important that this is signed as soon as possible and sent back to the school.

This year's Halloween festivities will soon be underway. We will be having a dressing up day for all students and staff on the last day of school before autumn holiday 28th of October. On this day students can come in Halloween costumes, but please note we will not accept any masks, weapon accessories, or offensive and discriminatory outfits of any kind. Next Friday, 14th October we will raise awareness of the Rosabandet campaign and encourage students and staff to wear pink for the day.

The students will have lessons as normal up to lunch time, where they will have some Halloween themed lessons in the afternoon during their normal scheduled hours.

On Friday 21st of October the school is closed for all students and fritids.

All IES Schools will have a Regional conference. We will welcome two other schools into IES Upplands Väsby this year, IES Sigtuna and IES Värmdö.
